Directions to Middlesbrough Football Club

Please enter via the main reception area

From the South

Leave the A1 at Dishforth

Take the A168 which then leads you to the A19, continue along the A19

Take the sliproad for A66 Middlesbrough.

Follow the A66 past Middlesbrough Town Centre on a raised section of Dual Carriageway, following signs for Redcar, Grangetown and Teesport.

You will see the Stadium on the Left Hand Side.

At the first roundabout, turn left (the first exit).

Go straight over the next roundabout and over the bridge.

Turn right at the third roundabout and the stadium car park is on the right.

From the North

Along the A1 on to the A689 for Teesside

Go straight over 5 Roundabouts past Wynyard Park and Samsung. At the 6th Roundabout take the 3rd Exit on the A19 Southbound heading for Middlesbrough.

Follow the A19 and take the A66 turn off to Middlesbrough.
